Doing missions...

It was our privilege to take an international high school choir on a 10 day mission trip to Germany in March. They sang 11 concerts, for which Valerie was the accompanist, and participated in 2 youth rallies and 2 nursing home ministries, among other activities such as passing out flyers and squeezing in 2 days of sightseeing. Beau was the “chaplain” bringing a very pertinent spiritual lesson each day and Valerie taught the girls a lesson each night. The highlight of the trip was Beau being able to share the gospel very clearly with a Nepalese (Hindu) 10th grader. While he didn’t get saved on the trip, counting the cost of his decision and the repercussions within his family, he did speak to his principal a week after we arrived back in Portugal and accepted Christ as his Savior.
