## PAPERWORK

Beau and Avery have renewed their temporary visas three times, every 2 years. Valerie has a permanent resident visa, and Owen doesn't require a visa since he was born in Portugal and is considered a "Portuguese citizen". Since we have now been Portuguese residents for over 6 years, Beau and Avery are eligible to apply for a five year, permanent visa. Permanent visas are a fraction of the cost to renew and last five whole years!! Their visas are eligible for renewal in December and if they aren't renewed, they will start the 6 year count over again, with 3 more temporary visas. Since we cannot afford to lose this opportunity, Beau will be traveling to Portugal on the 14<sup>th</sup> of December to renew their visas.
